

## Road Closures (March 8, 2010)

March 13 -- Street closures for [Fort Lauderdale St. Patrick's Day Parade and Festival](#):


- E. Las Olas Blvd. from Andrews Ave. to SE 1 Ave closed 7am to midnight.
- E. Las Olas Blvd. from SE 1 Ave. to SE 9 Ave. closed approximately 10 am to 5 pm.
- SE 2nd Ave., SE 3 Ave. and SE 6 Ave. will be kept open up to approximately 2 p.m. for north/south crossing of E. Las Olas Blvd. All will then be closed from approximately 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. to accommodate the parade.
- Business and residential traffic south of E. Las Olas Blvd. and west of SE 6 Ave. (downtown) should utilize SE 9 Ave. and SE 11 Ave. to enter/exit the neighborhood throughout the day.:

S.R. A1A (N. Ocean Boulevard) in Fort Lauderdale will have a lane closed IN EACH DIRECTION periodically between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday, March 1, through Friday, March 5.

I-95 will have up to three NORTHBOUND lanes closed for a mile at a time from the I-595 connector ramp to north of Broward Boulevard along with a lane on the I-595 connector ramp to I-95 NORTHBOUND overnight between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday nights.

The Henry Kinney Tunnel on S. Federal Highway (U.S. 1) south of Broward Boulevard in downtown Fort Lauderdale will be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. to all NORTHBOUND traffic Tuesday night, March 9, and to all SOUTHBOUND traffic Wednesday night, March 10. The detour route is S.E. 3rd Avenue to the west from Broward Boulevard north of the tunnel and S.E. 7th Street south of the tunnel.

SR-736/Davie Blvd., closure at FEC RR crossing; this detour will be maintained from Sunday March 7, 2010 at 7:00 a.m. to Wednesday March 10, 2010 at 6:00 a.m.

The SW 11th Avenue Swing Bridge is closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic for approximately one year to undergo a complete overhaul and rehabilitation. The bridge is anticipated to reopen mid-August 2010. See [detour plan map](#) .
